Principles

The information to be included on parchments is determined by the following considerations:

- a! attractiveness
- b! prominence of the name of " alhousie #niversity, the name of the student, and the degree that has been conferred and its defining characteristics honours, advanced ma\$or, ma\$or, cooperative education!
- c! consistency in terms of the amount of information for students in all programs in each program level, i%e%, undergraduate, & aster* and " octoral
- d! culture and licensing' accreditation re(uirements of particular professional fields
- e! production manageability within the time available

Practices

- a! Institutional Identification

The name, crest and seal of " alhousie #niversity will appear on all parchments.) o other #niversity's crest or seal will be included, e+cept for , partnership- degrees such as those with the) ova Scotia Agricultural . ollege and the #niversity of / ing*s . ollege, and the & aster*s degrees in O omen*s Studies.

- b! Signatures

3resident will be the only signatures on parchments, e+cept for , partnership- degrees, provided that the signatures can be scanned.

- c! Degree Description

The name of the degree and defining characteristics honours, ma\$or, double ma\$or, cooperative program, and field of study, where applicable! will be inclhr.
